

## 15 AGENCIES REMOVE EXPORT FEES

In line with the implementation of the Executive Order 554, Directing all Departments, Bureaus, Commissions, Agencies, Offices and Instrumentalities of the National Government-Owned and/or Controlled Corporations, to improve the competitiveness of the country's export sector by eliminating the fees and charges imposed on export clearances, inspections, permits, certificates, and other documentation requirements, the following agencies eliminated their export related fees and charges:
